

Community members: WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW.

Face Coverings and Stage Three Reopening Instructions from Public Health Sudbury & Districts¹

Effective Friday, July 17, 2020, and unless you have an exemption, you will be required to wear a face covering in all Enclosed Public Spaces open in the Sudbury and Manitoulin districts.

The following are the details of these requirements:

1. All businesses and organizations in the Sudbury and Manitoulin districts must have a policy to ensure that no one is permitted to enter or remain in an Enclosed Public Space of a business or organization, including a public transit vehicle, unless they are wearing a face covering.
2. The face covering requirement applies to employees and members of the public.
3. There are exemptions to the face covering requirement such as those based on health conditions, young age, and religious or cultural beliefs.
4. No business is to require proof of any exemption.
5. The policy is to be acted on in good faith and used primarily as a means of educating people about face covering.
6. Businesses and organizations must have hand sanitizer available at entrances and exits, post signage, and provide verbal reminders as necessary.

Everyone is reminded of the importance of keeping two metres apart from people not in your social circle, staying home when ill and getting tested for COVID-19.
