Who We Are

Anyone who wants to stop using
drugs may become a member of
Narcotics Anonymous. (NA).

Membership is not limited
to addicts using any particular
drug. Those that feel they may
have a problem with drugs, legal
or illegal including alcohol, are
welcome in NA. Recovery in NA
focuses on the problem of addic-
tion, not any particular drug.

What We Are

Narcotics Anonymous is a non-
profit, international, community-
based organization for recover-
ing addicts.

Narcotics Anonymous members
learn from one another how to
live drug free and recover from
the effects of addiction in their
lives.

Where We Are

Most NA meetings are regularly
held at the same time and place
each week, usually in a public
place. There are two basic types
of meetings, those which are
open to the public, and those
which are closed to the public
(for addicts only).

NA meetings are formally struc-
tured. The function of the meet-
ing is always the same, to pro-
vide a suitable and reliable envi-
ronment for recovery.

TELL YOURSELF:

JUST FOR TODAY my thoughts will be on
my recovery, living and enjoying life with-
out the use of drugs.

JUST FOR TODAY I will have faith in
someone in NA who believes in me and
wants to help me in my recovery.

JUST FOR TODAY I will have a program. I
will try to follow it to the best of my ability.

JUST FOR TODAY, through NA, I will try
to get a better perspective on my life.

JUST FOR TODAY I will be unafraid. My
thoughts will be on my new associations,
people who are not using and who have
found a new way of life. So long as I follow
that way, I have nothing to fear.

NA meetings are held regularly at
the same time and place each week,
usually in a public facility. There
are two basic types of meetings-
(Open) those that are open to the
general public and (Closed) for ad-
dicts only or those who think they
may have a problem with the dis-
ease of Addiction and closed to the
public.

Meetings vary widely in format.
Some formats are: participation,
speaker, question and answer, topic
discussion, and some have a combi-
nation of these formats. The func-
tion of any meeting is always the
same: to provide a suitable and reli-
able environment for personal re-
covery.
