For your protection, and the protection of our members and their families, we require you to read and agree to the following terms and conditions:

Sudbury Area Campout Committee is not responsible for the following:

- lost or stolen items
- physical, mental, emotional or spiritual wellbeing
- mediating personal conflicts
- the financial costs incurred due to physical injuries or damages to personal properties

When using or occupying any portion of this facility you are responsible:

I/We agree to maintain the lodging allocated to me/us and report any damage to a member of the Campout Committee.

I/We understand that failure to do so or to leave the lodging in disarray will result in my/our forfeiting the opportunity to acquire lodging at future Sudbury Area Campouts. This means sweeping room, emptying garbage and wiping down furniture if required.

Rules and Regulations for Campout Event:

1. Smoking is not permitted anywhere on the campground except at the campfire area. This includes the use of E-cigarettes and E-vapor.
2. No motorized land vehicles (quads, dirt bikes) except for campout committee use.
3. Camper under the age of sixteen must be accompanied by an adult who is camping on the premises.
4. **NO** pets allowed in dorm (as per request of owner).
5. Pets must be leashed at all times and owners are responsible to poop and scoop.
6. Children must be supervised at all times.
7. Payment of all fees due at the start of campout.
8. Personal food may not be stored in walk-in cooler or freezer in the dining hall.
9. There should be no drugs, drug paraphernalia, or alcohol on the premises. Any person found to be in possession of, or under the influence of above may be asked to leave following a closed meeting of SACCNA and said member. When participant is asked to leave balance of registration

- fees/meal tickets will be refunded. This shall be done in a responsible and safe manner.
10. When campout fees paid by a third party and registrant leaves early, refund will be allocated to third party only.
 11. Official registration/room allocation is 1pm. Check-out time is 10am on the final day of campout. Check-out time during campout will be noon, at which time campers are to move their belongings from the room they have been occupying.
 12. Violent and aggressive behavior has no place at campout. Anyone displaying such behavior may be asked to leave, pending the outcome of an open meeting of campout committee. The party in question will be invited to attend such meeting.
 13. Room allocation authorized by SACCNA member only, changes must be approved by same.
 14. When assigning rooms to participants, 18 and under, at least one responsible adult or guardian must be included in the room assignment. In the event that a member is under

the age of 18 it is the responsibility of SACCNA to assign that member a room with and adult in it.

15. We ask that there be no loitering on docks after midnight.

16. There is zero tolerance for bullying. Parent, or guardian, said child, and two committee members will meet and discuss situation. SACCNA policy will be explained and warning given. If bullying persists child shall be asked to leave in the company of a parent or guardian. Balance of registration and/or meal tickets shall be refunded.
